The Commission advises City Council, the Planning Commission, and City staff on the planting, preservation, and removal of trees on public property, improving the urban forest to provide a better quality of life and health for residents, and secure meaningful environmental and aesthetic benefits.

Working with partner community organizations, the Commission also strives to enhance the diversity and health of the City's tree canopy, educate the community about the critical importance of trees, plant trees in low canopy neighborhoods, and advocate for public and private resources and engagement. When and where appropriate, the Commission advises on the protection of trees and tree canopy on private property.

- The Commission meets via Zoom at 5:00pm on the First Tuesday of every month.
- Appointments are for three-years.
- You must be a resident of Charlottesville to serve on the Commission.
